Skilz Doubles Tournament will run two days starting on Saturday, May 17, 2008 at 11am and end on Sunday, May 18, 2008 at the end of bowling for the 4m squad.

This handicap tournament is open to all men & women sanctioned bowlers. A team will consist of 1 man and 1 woman, 2 men or 2 women. **Current PBA/PWBA members are welcome but only one per team.** All bowlers must be entered handicap doubles event in order to participate in any other optional event for that squad. No two bowling center employees can bowl or alibi together.

This tournament will be any combination Handicap Doubles tournament with optional scratch singles. Scores bowled in the doubles event will be used for all optional events for the same squad. Bowlers will bowl **three (3) games across six (6) lanes.** Bowlers may re enter as often as they wish, but may **cash only once** with the **same partner!**

Handicap shall be based on 80% of 200, 30 pins max-Men & 40 pins max-Women. Entrants will use their highest yearbook league average based on minimum of 21 games for the 2006/2007 season. If none they will use their highest current league average of 21 games or more. If their current league average is 10 pins or higher, then their current league average will be used. If you don't meet any of the above mention criteria you will bowl scratch (200 avg.). Correction in average may be permitted up to the completion of the first game of the series. All averages must be verified prior to entering the tournament. Bowlers are responsible for verifying their own average. All bowlers will be required to initial their average on the recap sheet.
